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Worked up in Pure Merino DK, these little vests are a quick and easy knit and comfortable to wear on a cooler day or under a jacket when it's cold.

The Small Print.

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You will need:

- ColourSpun Pure Merino DK OR ColourSpun Pure Cotton DK
2 – 4 x 50g depending on size chosen
- 4mm knitting needles or size to achieve correct tension

Abbreviations

K	knit
P	purl
Decrease	Knit the next 2 sts together
Stst	stocking stitch
DR	double rib (K2;P2)
LF	left front
RF	right front

Tension

22 sts = 10cm

Back

Age	0-3m	3-6m	6-12m	12-18m	18-24m	2-3y	3-4y	
width	21	23.5	25	26	28	30	33	cm
length	22	23	24	25	27	30	36	cm
Cast on	46	50	54	58	62	66	74	sts
work	6	6	6	8	8	10	10	Rows DR
Cont. in Stst for	13	13.5	14	14.5	15.5	17	20	cm (end on purl row)
Decrease	1	1	1	1	1	1	1	St each side of next row
Work DR until work is	22	23	24	25	27	30	36	cm. Cast off in DR

Front

Age	0-3m	3-6m	6-12m	12-18m	18-24m	2-3y	3-4y	
Width	21	23.5	25	26	28	30	33	cm
length	22	23	24	25	27	30	36	cm
Cast on	46	50	54	58	62	66	74	sts
work	6	6	6	8	8	10	10	Rows DR
Cont. in Stst for	13	13.5	14	14.5	15.5	17	20	cm (end on purl row)
Decrease	1	1	1	1	1	1	1	St each side of next row
RF – work DR on first	22	24	26	28	30	32	36	Sts, leave LF sts on hold
Work DR until work is	22	23	24	25	27	30	36	cm. Cast off in DR
LF – work DR on next	22	24	26	28	30	32	36	Sts
Work DR until work is	22	23	24	25	27	30	36	cm. Cast off in DR

Finishing

Divide the back top into thirds and mark with pins.
Thread yarn through each front shoulder and gather evenly to measure 1 third of back.
Join at shoulders, make sure that the middle third of the back is left to form the back neck line. Join the side seams.
